- the applicant's previous academic record and conclusions drawn about the student's academic promise,
- · evidence of plans to attend university program following completion of secondary schooling,
- · review of confidential recommendations received,
- evidence of agreement with the school's expectations, policies and requirements, and
- the level of maturity as recognized through application documentation and a personal interview.

A completed application includes the following:

- 1. Submission of an accurately-completed Student Application Form along with recent photo.
- 2. Payment of the application fee (€ 150.00)
- 3. Submission of up-to-date copies of original school transcripts and reports with translation (if necessary) which include the previous academic year for applicants for grades 7 through 9, and records representing any of the high school years (grades 9 through 12) for those applicants seeking enrollment at AIS-Salzburg in grades 10, 11, or 12, and complete high school transcripts with proof of diploma reception for all post-graduate applicants.
- 4. Submission of a copy of the applicant's current, valid passport photo page.
- 5. Submission of copies of any relevant visas or residency permits that are relevant to living and studying in Salzburg, Austria.
- 6. Reception of a confidential reference from the most-recent English and mathematics instructors.
- 7. A visit to the school, including interview with the applicant or an online visit with an Admissions Team member.

Once all of the following are received, the AIS-Salzburg Admissions Team will review and discuss the application. An admission decision, once made, will be communicated with the student and parents immediately afterwards. In some cases, the Admissions Team may request clarification, further information, or a language proficiency test either at the school or with a proctor.

AIS-Salzburg has a rolling admissions process and accepts and processes student applications at any time during the year.
